All participating horses must be AMHA registered. Stallions three years and older must have a stallion certificate in order to participate. All horses must be measured. Stalls are \$50.00 for Monday - Wednesday (two horse maximum). All horses must be stables. A grounds fee of \$5.00 per horse will be charged. Valid AMHA registration, youth and/or amateur numbers, and current coggins (within 1 year), and health certificate within 30 days on out of state horses must be provided. ## General Rules and Information

- Entry Fees:**     **Class Fee:** \$20.00 per class  
**Flat Fee for AMHA Show:** \$100.00 per horse (Pre-Entry Only)  
**Pre-entry deadline:** January 20, 2018  
**Post Entry Fee:** \$10.00 per class
- Youth Classes:** All youth must have an AMHA Youth number to participate. An application may be filled out at the Horse Show Office day of show if needed. **AMHA youth are those youth 18 years & under as of January 1, 2018.**
- Amateur Classes:** An AMHA Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$10.00 to AMHA members; \$50.00 to non-members. Applications are available at the Horse Show Office. Amateurs showing in Amateur/AOTE classes must be the owner of the horse or an immediate family member. **AOTE horses must not have been handled by a professional handler under any circumstance since December 31, 2017.**
- Measuring:** Measuring will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 12 through 8:00 p.m. and each morning thereafter from 8:00 – 9:00 a.m. each day or at a scheduled time as requested in the show office. All horses must be measured. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measuring.
- Office Information:** Please have a copy of your horse's coggins (within 1 year) available, 30 day health certificate on out-of-State horses, & copy of registration showing both sides. Owners of senior stallions (3 yrs. & older) must present a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection for cryptorchidism to show management prior to participating in an AMHA approved show. Judges Evaluation Cards will be available in the Show Office, and may be completed on a voluntary basis.
- Entries:** All entry forms, copies of both sides of the AMHA registration papers for each horse, lease agreements, copy of Coggins papers, copy of Amateur and/or Youth cards, copy of Veterinary Inspection for Senior Stallions, and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, AMHA fee, RV fees, etc., are to be sent to Show Manager Laura Mullen. Checks are to be made payable to FSFA. Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class.
- Refunds:** There will be no refunds given on any entries or fees. Substitutions will be accepted.
- PA System:** It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. Gate holds will be limited to 2 minutes. Tack holds need to be requested with the gateperson.
- Conduct:** Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.
- Special Needs Exhibitors:** Special needs exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice if any special arrangements need to be made. Please contact the show manager.

- Stabling:** Box stalls available for \$50 for Monday-Wednesday (maximum of 2 horses per stall). Stall fees are the same for horses or tack. Shavings available on the show grounds for a fee. Use of straw as bedding is prohibited. Stall cleanings to be dumped in designated areas ONLY.
- Smoking:** No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.

Take I 75 South to Exit 260 and merge right only Martin Luther King Boulevard. Going west, pass light at US Hwy 301 and go to next light at Orient Road. Fairgrounds entrance on right.

**From I 75 South or North from Ocala or Sarasota:**  
I 75 N to Exit 260B. Merge left onto Martin Luther King Boulevard (SR 574 West).  
I 75 S to Exit 260A. Merge right onto Martin Luther King Boulevard (SR 574 West)  
Right at Orient Road. Fairgrounds entrance on right.
