<u>Entry Fees</u> :	Open Classes: \$20.00 Per Class Flat Fee: \$100.00 Per Horse (Pre-Entry Only) Pre-entry deadline: January 20, 2018
Youth Classes:	Youth may show without a membership, but all youth must have an ASPC/AMHR Youth number to be eligible for any ASPC/AMHR/ASPR Youth Awards. An application may be filled out with the ASPC/AMHR Steward. Youth membership is free.
<u>Amateur</u> <u>Classes</u> :	An ASPC/AMHR Amateur Card is required to participate in Amateur classes. Amateur cards are \$15.00 if applied for at the show. Exhibitors must be a member of ASPC/AMHR to apply. Applications are available from the show steward.
<u>Measuring</u> :	Measuring will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 12 through 8:00 p.m. and each morning thereafter from $8:00 - 9:00$ a.m. each day or at a scheduled time as requested in the show office. All horses must be measured or present a valid measurement card. Exhibitor packets and numbers will be issued after measurement. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at measuring.
<u>Office</u> Information:	Please have a copy of your horse's coggins (within 1 year) available, 30 day health certificate on out-of- State horses, & copy of registration showing both sides. Judges and Show Evaluation forms will be available in the Show Office and may be completed on a voluntary basis.
<u>Entries</u> :	All entry forms, copies of both sides of the ASPC/AMHR registration papers for each horse, copy of Amateur and/or Youth cards, and a check/money order in payment of classes, stalls, RV fees, etc., are to be sent to Show Manager Laura Mullen. Checks are to be made payable to FSFA. Coggins and health papers may be presented at check in. Entries postmarked after the pre-entry deadline will be assessed a post-entry fee of \$5.00 per class.
Refunds:	There will be no refunds given on any entries or fees. Substitutions will be accepted.
<u>PA System</u> :	It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. Tack holds need to be requested with the gateperson.
<u>Conduct</u> :	Cruelty, abuse or inhumane treatment of any horse in the show ring, barn, stalls or on the fairgrounds is strictly prohibited. The use of stimulants or depressants or any drug affecting the showing of a horse is forbidden.
<u>Special Needs</u> <u>Exhibitors</u> :	Special needs exhibitors are welcome to show. We would appreciate advance notice if any special arrangements need to be made. Please contact the show manager.

<u>Stabling</u> :	Box stalls available for \$50 for horse or tack for Monday-Wednesday (maximum of 2 horses per stall). All horses must be stabled. Shavings available on the showgrounds. Use of straw as bedding is prohibited. Stall cleanings to be dumped in designated areas only. Showing off the trailer is permitted at \$60.00 for up to two horses. Horses MAY NOT BE LEFT TIED FOR AN EXTENDED TIME BY THE ARENA.
Smoking:	No smoking will be allowed in the barns, on deck, in the arena or in the horse show office.
